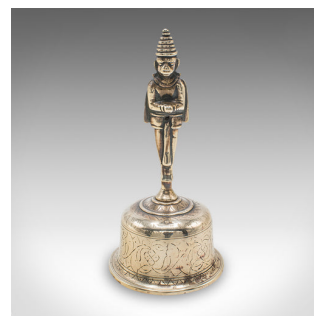


Antique Maid's Calling Bell, Indian, Bronze, Hanuman Deity, Ghanta, Victorian
