This is an antique county map of Hertfordshire. A Dutch, framed atlas engraving of cartographic interest by Joan Blaeu (1596 - 1673), dating to the mid 17th century and later, circa 1649.

- Superb mid-17th century lithography of Hertfordshire and its county detail
- Presents a desirable aged patina, with gently aged paper behind glass
- Fascinating cartography, appealingly set within a quality, later frame
- Broad and crafted in mahogany, the frame hosts mounting wire to the rear
- Original monochrome presentation and annotated with excellent town and county detail

- Likely an excerpt from Blaeu's *Theatrum Orbis Terrarum sive Atlas Novus*
