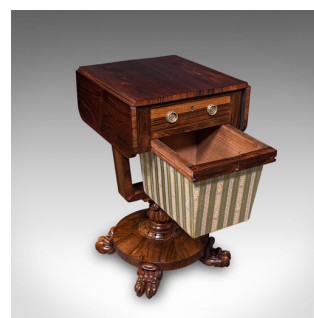


Antique Ladies Hobby Table, English, Drop Leaf, Sewing, Parlour, William IV

- Warm caramel hues beam beneath a wax polish finish
- Drop leaf top extends usefully, supported by articulated flying arms
- Front drawer dressed with circular brass drop handles
- Drawer fascia and wool box dressed with inset brass lined locks — untested, key absent
- Interior offers a sliding divider tray, which can also be removed if required
- Faux drawer fascia to the reverse affords central room placement
