This is an antique butler's tray table. An English, mahogany and brass drop-flap serving stand, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Demi-lune falls fold outwards to create a generous oval serving surface
 - Quality brass hinges articulate smoothly, offering a robust action for confident carrying

- With sides raised, butler's grasps to each side provide excellent purchase for service from kitchen to stand

- Tray sits upon the taut webbed stand, ensuring stable placement during use
- Striking X-frame legs with brass handles upon the folding axis
- Conveniently folds away for stowage when not in use
