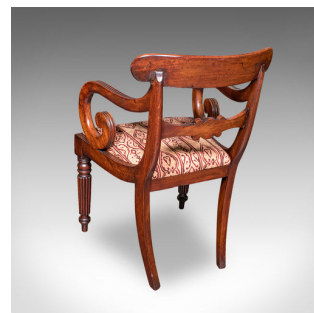
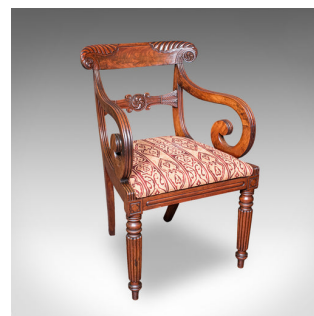


Pair of Antique Morning Room Elbow Chairs, English, Reception Seat, William IV
