This is an antique City of Exeter Map. An English, framed atlas excerpt by Cole and Roper, dating to the Georgian period, circa 1805.

- Pleasingly preserved atlas excerpt, showing the Devon city during the Georgian period

- Displays a desirable aged patina, with minimal foxing commensurate with age
- Presented behind clear, bright glass within a tasteful later frame
- Finished with ebonised and gilt tones with mounting wire to the reverse

- Superb copperplate Itaglio committed to the contemporary laid paper
- Hand coloured, the streets of Exeter and river accentuated in yellow and blue respectively

- Reference to the side lists the North, East, South and West administrative wards
- Bears the coat of arms and See of Exeter emblems in full colour

- Delightful vignette shows the Eastern view of the striking Cathedral
