This is a large antique map of the West India Islands. A Scottish, framed triptych of three Caribbean Leeward islands, dating to the late Georgian period, circa 1817.

A fine excerpt from John Thompson's (1777 - 1841) A New General Atlas of 1817, presenting the three islands from the Caribbean Leeward Isles with contemporary naming - Guadeloupe, Mariegalante and Antigua.

- Impressive scale and appealing 19th century cartography as entered within an atlas
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in gently time-worn order, commensurate with age
- Set within a tasteful later frame, behind clear and bright glass
- Map within a cream card border, with mounting wire to the reverse

- Engraved by Kirkwood & Son of Edinburgh from John Thompson's cartography
- Presents Guadeloupe, Antigua and Marie-Galante as individual insets
- Each hand-coloured to the border, and annotated with a high level of detail
- Shows place names, topography and scale for each island
