This is a vintage county map of Somerset. An English, atlas reproduction of the Thomas Moule original, dating to the late 20th century, circa 1980.

- Endearing mid-19th century cartography, after the renowned Thomas Moule
- Displaying a desirable aged patina and in good vintage order
- Presented behind diffusion glass for a soft, matte finish
- Later frame with ebonised and gilt border, dressed with hanging wire to the reverse
- Fascinating cartography, as expected of the renowned Thomas Moule (1784 - 1851)
- Gives excellent detail to Somersetshire as it was known in period
- Accentuated with heraldic elements with the crest of Wells and Bath respectively
- Hand colouring adds borders and distinction to the decorative touches
- Architectural vignette shows Glastonbury Cross, a market cross in the town
