- Depicting battle scenes of horsemen, figures, trees, pagodas and bridges
- The end panels and back display well executed, calm, stylised scenes
- Typical shaped and etched, circular catch plate
- Opening to reveal generous storage space divided by a single shelf
- Accompanied by the wonderful aroma of the camphor wood

A delightful piece in mellow tones. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
