- Marked with the craftsman's stamped initials 'J.J.M and R. Tyzack'
- Also carrying the King George V Government audit stamp
- Deep, shaped crest rail for added back support
- Running seamlessly into the shaped, scrolled armrests
- \bullet The back raised on a delightful and well executed shaped lath fan
- Drop in seat pad finished in a quality cloth, easy to recover
- Raised on turned legs united by double 'H' stretcher for strength
