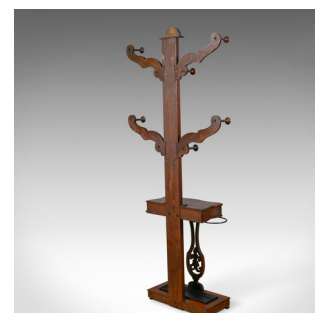
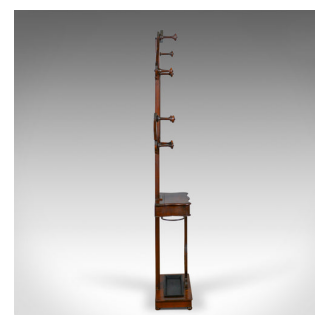
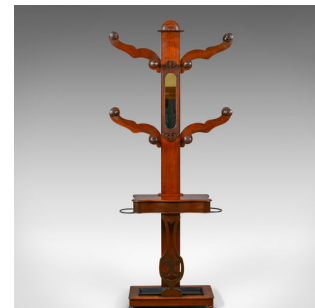


Antique Hall Stand, Edwardian, Mahogany, Tree, Hat, Coat, Umbrella, Circa 1910
