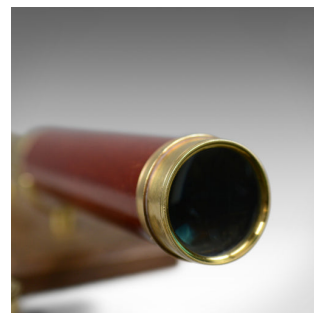
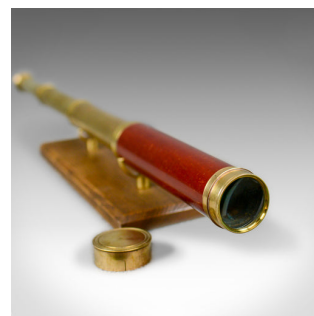


Antique Telescope, Three Draw, Refractor, Georgian, C. West, London c.1820
