This is an antique foot stool in walnut with a needlepoint tapestry cloth. An English provincial stool dating to the Regency period of the early 19th century, circa 1820.

- Deep, warm tones to the walnut frame
- Desirable colour and an aged patina
- In good order throughout, solid and stable
- Drop in seat pad, easily recovered to suit any décor
- Traditionally stuffed and well upholstered
- Attractive florally patterned needlepoint tapestry cloth
- Carved detail to the upper and lower apron
- Pegged joints strengthening the leg unions
- Cabriole legs with carved knee detail
- Standing upon claw and ball feet
