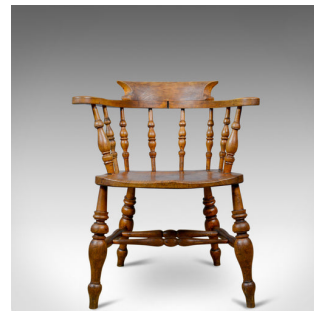


Antique Bow-Back Elbow Chair, English, Victorian, Smokers, Captains, Circa 1890
