Established in the mid 19th century (1850) in Bristol, England as a manufacturer of beds. The company displayed it's iron and brass bedsteads in a showroom at 15 St. Augustine's Parade. It grew to become a more general manufacturer and retailer of furniture, trading from a department store at 70-72 Queen's Road until it's closure in the 1970's.
