- Solidly jointed and robust – ideal for daily use
- Delightfully carved back-splat rising to a pierced, shaped crest rail
- Strong supportive arms with hand-carved detailing
- Traditionally upholstered, leather stuff-over seat pad with studded brass finish
- Generous in size and offering a useful 51cm (20.1") seat height
- Established on a well-braced box and 'H' stretcher for stability
- The baluster turned fore stretcher displaying good colouration
