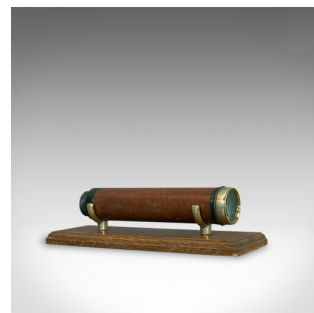


Antique Telescope, Bancks and Son, English, 3 Draw, Late 18th Century, C.1800
