This is an antique bureau bookcase, an English, late Georgian, mahogany writing desk c.1800.

- A very fine bureau bookcase in flame mahogany displaying good colour and grain interest
- Featuring good proportions, useful storage, generous workspace and secret drawers
- A pair of 14 pane astragal glazed doors sit beneath a well figured frieze
- Elaborate, pierced bronzed lock escutcheons topped with spread eagles
- Working lock and key opening doors to reveal a pair of adjustable shelves
- The fall with working lock and key through moulded asymmetric lock escutcheon
- Superb grain detail and a frame of roped inlay in boxwood and ebony
- Opening to reveal a generous workspace at a comfortable height
- A professionally fitted, fine suede writing surface
- Triple arched cubbies complemented by a suite of five drawers to each side
- Dressed with circular bronzed pulls featuring lion masks
