Bearing all the classic detailing and dating from circa 1760/1770, this exquisite pair of chairs have generous proportion, even by today's standards. Crafted from heavy mahogany the chairs display a deep, original colour and patina with a subtle grace and presence in a fusion of style and substance. The moulded square front legs and 'kicked' rear legs are united by a strong H-stretcher with additional rear rail for added stability. The subtle detailing of the moulding and chamfered inside of the front legs a sign of quality and attention to detail to be found on this genuine pair of historic chairs. The sinuous arms rise beautifully aside the drop-in seat cushions that have been professionally reupholstered in a quality leather and afford a comfortable, generous seat. The pierced back splat sits in a detailed, moulded shoe and rises to the elegant top rail terminating in attractive, modest ears so typical of the period. Stunning in every way, this pair of chairs are of superb quality, presented in excellent antique condition. Solid joints and construction. Delivered ...
