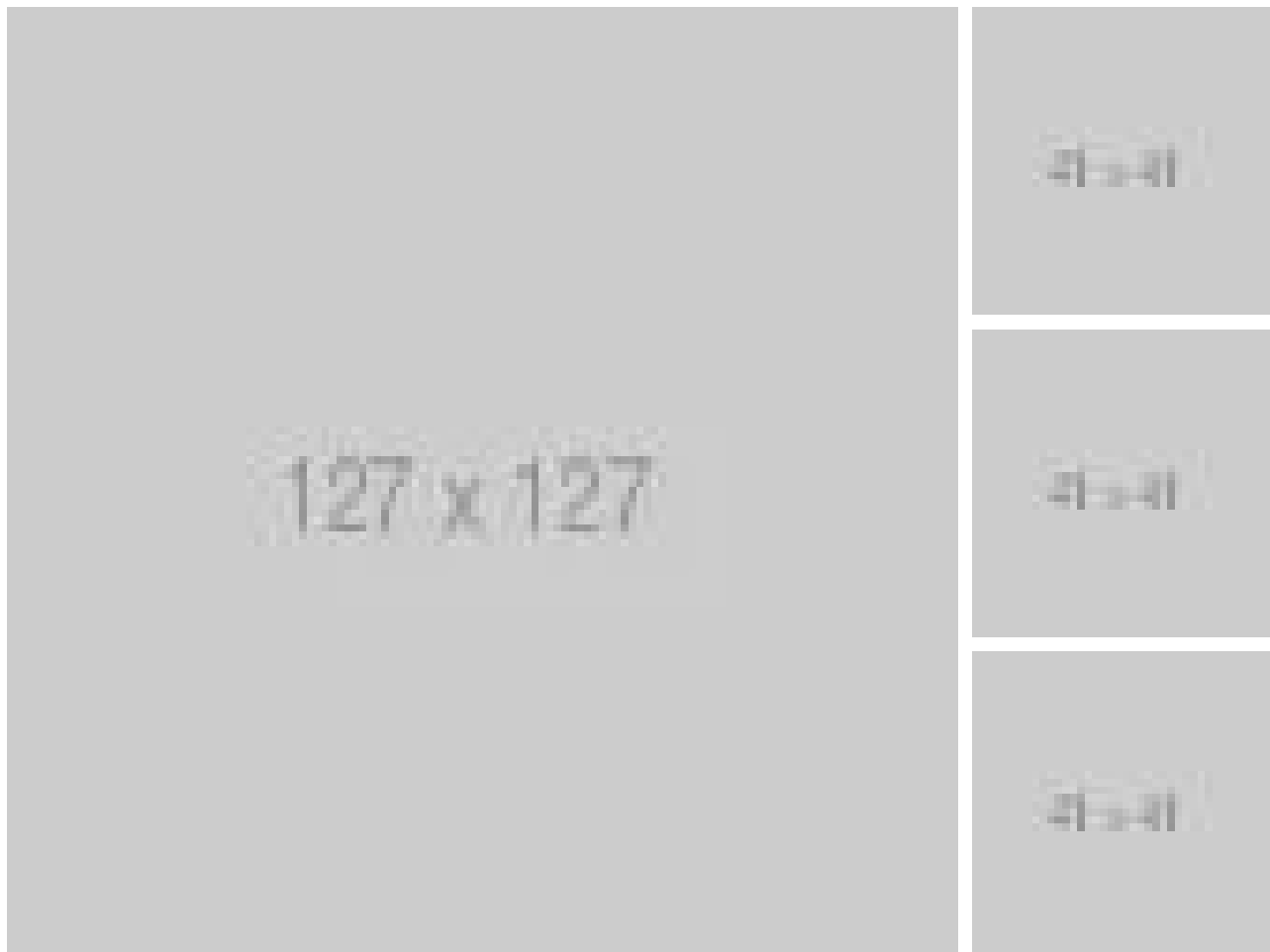


Victorian Writing Table, c.1880



DESCRIPTION

Our Stock # LFA-1209 This is a Victorian, antique, English Oak, leather topped writing desk dating to c.1880. A superior example presented in excellent antique condition, solidly constructed in well figured oak displaying excellent colour and patina. The solid top with moulded edge has been professionally fitted with a new, wine, leather skiver, writing surface, triple tooled with gold embossed edge detailing. Rising on an attractive turned leg base with three quarter stretcher and fluted flanks, the desk offers a finished back for centre room placement. Twin deep drawers flank a central drawer with the arch form knee-hole a generous 61cm (24") under height. The attractive proportions provide superb storage and practicality with a 76cm (29.9") desk height for comfort in use. The smooth sliding drawers with strong joints feature inlaid fronts displaying floral detail in ebony and boxwood. Original solid brass drop pulls with pierced back plates dress the triple drawer configuration with filing dividers inside one. A classic oak desk table in excellent antique condition and a piece to be welcomed into any location. Delivered waxed, polished & ready for the home.
