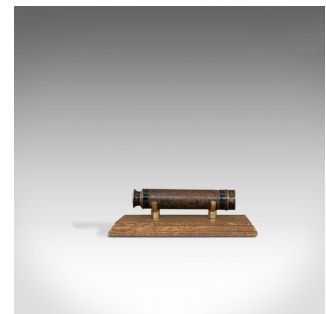


Antique Pocket Telescope, English, Brass, Leather, 3 Draw, Refractor, Victorian
