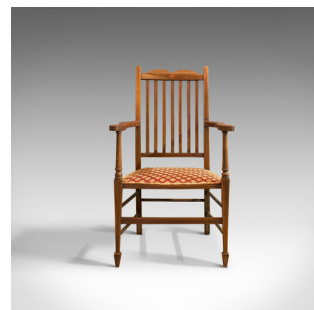


Antique Open Armchair, English, Mahogany, Elbow, Chair, Edwardian
