This is an antique travel trunk. An English, tin shipping chest in the name of T.B. Wildman, vice consulate for Great Britain in Punta Arenas, Chile and dating to the early 20th century, circa 1919.

- Weathered tin evocative of T.B. Wildman's journeys across oceans and continents
- Original paper labels provide further documentary interest
- Dome-top lid operates smoothly on rear-mounted hinges
- Shipping label to the right-hand side of the lid
- Broad central beam and a pair of internal staves fortify the lid
- Maker's mark stamped into the leading edge - S. Hunt & Sons, Ironmongers, Liverpool

- Each side dressed with a loop handle for carriage
- Left-hand handle featuring a repository label for Harvey Nichols in Bournemouth
