- Stout lid resplendent with wisps of medullary rays
- Edges decorated with fantastic, naive chipping
- Stiles and muntins presented with ornate scroll and acanthus motif
- Inset frieze panels with diamond foliate carving, complemented by patera
- Lid opens upon original wire hook hinge
- Iron lock escutcheon with broad clasp - key absent
- Interior benefits from an enclosed candle box - superb medullary rays within
