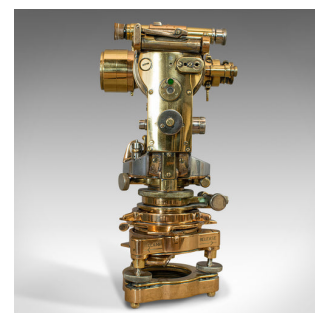


Vintage Theodolite, English, Scientific Instrument, Cooke Troughton & Simms

This is a vintage theodolite. An English, brass scientific instrument, by Cooke, Troughton and Simms, dating to the mid 20th century, circa 1950.

- Displays a desirable aged patina

- Main telescope barrel rotates full 360-degrees on its axis
- Primary viewing objective of 35mm (1.5")
- Secondary targeting sight situated above the primary barrel
- Upper spirit level with built-in sun shade – level fluid absent
- Each adjustment knob finished with attractive, tightly knurled grips
- Engraved with the maker's mark for Cooke, Troughton and Simms, Ltd, of York
- Serial and Patent numbers of V03948 and 51.148 respectively
