- Broad, solid rosewood writing surface with a hand-carved pie crust edge

- Inset brass lock escutcheon to central drawer key absent
- Stout shoulders testament to the craftsmanship of this piece
- Shaped front apron decorated with a pair of inset shell carvings
- Raised upon wonderful reeded, tapering legs and standing on tall turnip feet
