- Five compartments within a carriage frame
- Compartments dressed with iron studded corners
- Sliding stanchion helps keep trays secure

- Pierced upper apron replete with foliate carvings and further studded detail
- Carved end supports adorning each side of the chest platform
- Iron support arms terminate at the continuous plinth base
