This is an antique etagere. An Italian, ebonised mahogany and boxwood three tier whatnot, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1900.

- The eye-catching raised, pierced brass gallery sets the etagere off
 - Shaped upper tier benefits from quality boxwood marquetry – repeated on the lower tiers
 - Further marquetry decorates each fascia for 360-degree, central room placement
 - Opening drawer to the front dressed with an ornate brass handle with broad leaf motif
- Lower tier features a sinuous bowed knee
- Raised upon gently curving legs with splayed feet
