This is an antique spectrometer. A French, brass scientific instrument by Dr. J.G. Hofmann, dating to the mid-19th century, circa 1860.

- Affords the spectral analysis of stellar and nebular light
- Four small slits pass light through a system of five prisms
- Crown wheel to the side allows adjustment to different parts of the spectrum
- Engraved with the name J.G. Hofmann, Paris
- Supplied with dust-cap for the front element and removable eye-cup
- Presented in its box with a cobalt blue velour interior lining
