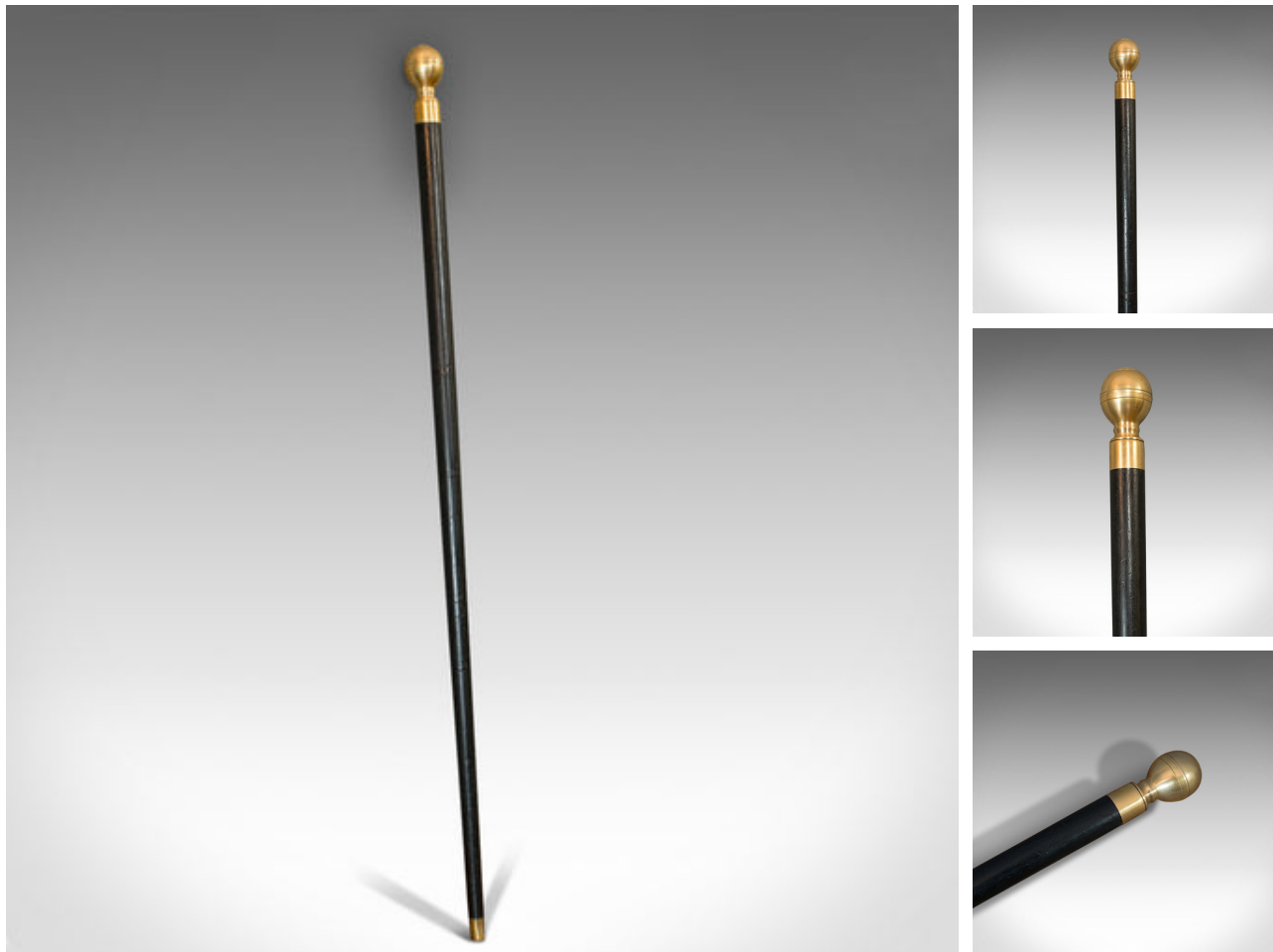


Antique Gadget Cane, English, Mahogany, Brass, Walking Stick, Edwardian, C.1910

This is an antique gadget cane. An English, mahogany and brass walking stick with concealed compass and flask, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Gentleman's cane at a comfortable height of 84.5cm (33.25")
- Displays a desirable aged patina
- Ebonised mahogany cane with dark hues throughout
- Brass ball handle in appealing golden finish
- Rounded ball handle feels good in the hand, with a pleasing balance
- Screw-top ball reveals a working compass with cardinal and inter-cardinal points
- Second screw at handle stem opens to present a sheathed flask
- Brass tip to end shows signs of use commensurate with age
