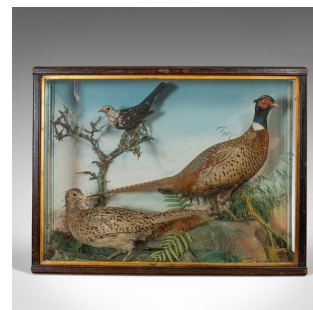


Antique Taxidermy Scene, Birds, Pheasant, Blackbird, Display Case, Victorian
