This is an antique Windsor chair. A British, elm and ash elbow or armchair, dating to the mid Victorian period, circa 1860.

- Appealing in colour with rich caramel hues
- The tall, shaped top rail benefits from a gently chamfered rear edge
- A pierced, shaped back splat sits between slender spindles
- Cow horn arms supported by turned balusters
- Traditional, carved saddle seat for comfort
- The seat base stamped with the Isle of Man triskelion
- Raised upon turned legs, with canted angles to the rear
- United by a H-stretcher with turned spindles
