This is an antique steamer trunk. An English, canvas and leather nautical or maritime travel case by the Army and Navy Co-operative Society, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Business-like exterior with a wonderfully nautical interior finish
- Displays a desirable aged patina
- · Canvas finish in good order
- Seams bound with contrasting brown leather
- The stout lid held in place with leather straps
- Broad leather vamp shields the lock mechanism
- \bullet Dressed with a sliding clasp and inset working lock key present
- Period travel labels to the front fascia
- Moving to the interior reveals a blue pinstriped textile lining
- Bright crimson details abound, with a fold-over pouch to the lid
- Leather straps reveal a stowage void within, with a versatile, folding compartment at
