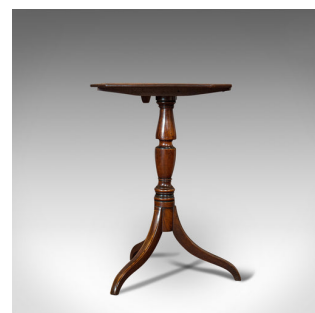
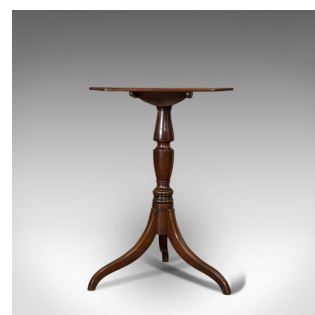
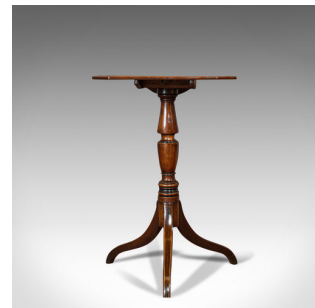




Antique Tripod Table, English, Flame Mahogany, Side, Wine, Regency, Circa 1820
