This is a vintage Ipswich wardrobe. An English, oak four panel cupboard from the Art Deco period, circa 1930.

- Wonderfully carved example
- Displays a desirable aged patina
- Select oak shows fine grain interest
- Deep caramel hues to the wax polish finish
- A discrete crown moulding sits above a delightfully carved pediment
- The tall, four-panel door catches the eye with superb linen fold carving
- Dressed with a small decorated lock escutcheon with inset, working lock
- The key being present and has an elaborate foliate design
- \bullet Door opens smoothly on fascinating, shaped butterfly hinges
- The interior arranged as a high shelf over a hanging rail
- Attractive, shaped lower aprons to the front and sides
