This is an antique mechanical engine indicator. A Scottish, brass scientific instrument by Dobbie-McInnes of Glasgow, dating to the early 20th century, circa 1920.

- Presenting a great deal of mechanical and historical interest
- Displays a desirable aged patina
- Self contained within a quality wooden case
- Industrial grade metal casing to the indicator shows minimal wear
- Measures the pressure upon a piston during its combustion cycle
- This force is logged to a paper roll attached to the drum
- Such devices favoured by power plants and Royal Navy, amongst others
- Replete with information labels and an insert card with graph to rear
- Period illustrations add further collector appeal
- Maker's mark can be found to the front fascia
 - Reads; Dobbie McInnes & Clyde, Glasgow – just one such mark as found

throughout the instrument
