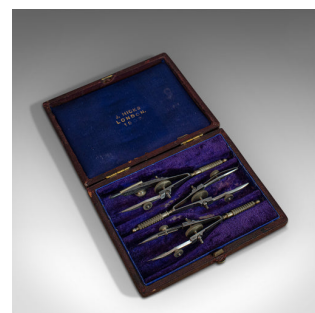


Small Antique Draughtsman's Compass Set, Architect's, Technical Drawing, Hicks
