

Victorian Set of Six Dining Chairs, c.1890



DESCRIPTION

Our Stock # LFA-1268 This is a set of 6 late Victorian, English, Chippendale revival dining chairs dating to c.1890. Raised upon swept rear and cabriole front legs with foliate carved knees tapering down into well executed claw and ball feet, these chairs are constructed in solid mahogany with good colour and a beautifully aged patina. The classic 'ribbon', pierced back splats feature a subtle pair of floral rosettes, sit neatly in the shoe and rise up to the serpentine crest rail that features carved detail to the sides flanking a central foliate motif. The drop in seats are covered in leather with three good and three showing aged splitting but are ripe for reupholstering and a relatively straight forward to do in a fabric or leather to suit any decor. The frames benefiting from makers stamps and marks beneath. Solid joints, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
