This is an antique serpentine arm chair. An English, mahogany elbow seat, dating to the Regency period, circa 1820.

- Attractive arm chair with alluring shape
- \bullet Displays a desirable aged patina some small marks to upholstery under closer inspection
 - Select mahogany shows rich caramel hues and fine grain interest
 - Later upholstery over a traditionally stuffed cushion
 - An incurved top rail begins the serpentine delights of the chair
 - Gently cascading arms terminate in broad scroll elbows
 - Balloon back lower cross rail unites the whole
 - \bullet Professionally reupholstered in a quality ivy green textile
 - The comfortable seat at a height of 44.5cm (17.5")
 - \bullet Golden brocade trim provides a contrast border around the lower edge
- Raised upon turned baluster legs with peg feet to front and gently splayed square section rears
