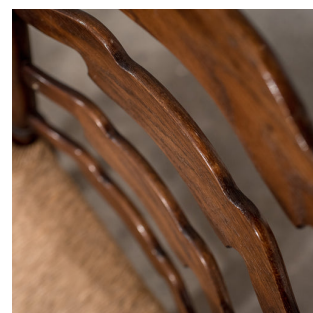
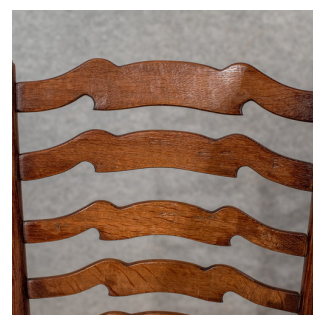


Set of 8 Antique Oak Wavy Line Ladderback Dining Chairs, Edwardian Circa 1910
