This is a vintage first aid chest. An English, pine trunk decorated for the Huddersfield Rifles regiment, dating to the mid 20th century circa 1960.

- Useful storage chest - ideal as coffee table
- Displays a desirable aged patina
- Dark painted pine with pleasing weathering
- Eye-catching red cross logo to front and rear fascia
- Dressed with an inset, working lock – key present
- A pair of iron drop handles to each side for carriage
- The lid reads '5th BWRR-GT, L.D. Ambulance Huddersfield'
- Likely the ambulance service for 5th Battalion, Duke of Wellington's Regiment of the Huddersfield Rifles
- Dovetail joints to each corner add strength

This is a fascinating vintage first aid chest, with markings suggesting a military role in its younger days. Ideally suited as a base for a coffee table, the generous size also offers a useful space for storage. Delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
