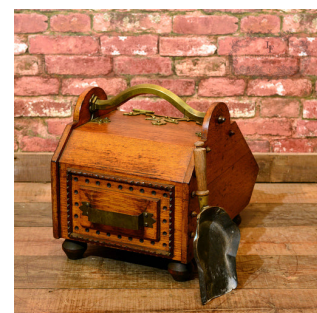
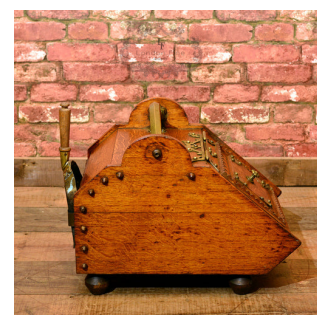


Victorian Oak Log Bin, Fireside Purdonium, c.1860

The octagonal carry handle shaped for comfort is complimented by a wonderful pierced brass hinge. The front has been decorated in galleried relief around a central oak plate further dressed with brass plates and a rosette pull. Opening the flap reveals an internal store ideal for kindling, logs or coal. To the rear of the box a useful shovel locates in a strap holder completing this attractive fire side store.
