- Copious dovetail joints add strength
- Hand-painted with the initials T.P.H. to lid and front fascia in crimson red
- Braced lid opens smoothly on a pair of long strap brackets
- Sliding and removable tool tray sits above the interior
- Working, inset brass-lined lock key present
- Dressed with a pair of iron loop handles with shaped backplates

This generously sized antique joiner's chest will offer many more years of useful storage with its stout build and quality craftsmanship. Its size also lends itself to being suitable as use as a coffee table base. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
