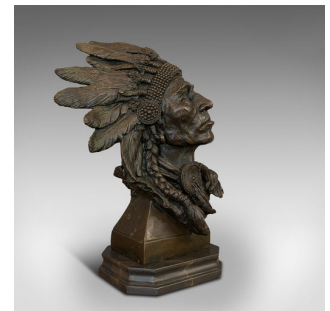


Large Vintage Native American Chief Bust, Bronze, Sculpture, Sioux, After Kauba

This is a large, vintage Native American chief bust. A Continental, bronze sculpture of a Sioux male in the manner of Carl Kauba (1865-1922), dating to the 20th century.
