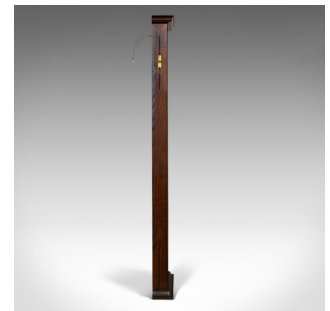


Vintage Admiral Fitzroy Barometer, Scientific Instrument, Reynolds & Branson

This is a vintage Admiral Fitzroy Barometer. An English, oak and glass scientific instrument with atmospheric dials by Reynolds & Branson of Leeds, dating to the early 20th century, circa 1930.
