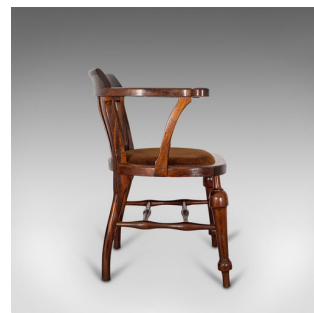


Antique Captain's Chair, English, Mahogany, Armchair, Seat, Edwardian, C.1910

- The rear legs of gently splayed circular form
- United by flared bar double 'H' stretcher for added strength
