



Large Antique Welsh Dresser, British, Oak, Sideboard, Cabinet, William III, 1700









DESCRIPTION

This is a large antique Welsh dresser. A British, dark stained oak sideboard cabinet, dating to the William III period of the 17th century and later, circa 1700.

- Of impressive proportions and striking decoration
- Displays a desirable aged patina
- Dark stained oak radiating highlights from the profusely carved stocks
- Charming 17th century craftsmanship from the William III period
- Crown moulding with decorative sash carving sits above the whole
- Tall back-rest featuring frieze panels, united by a set of 7 pot hooks at mid-height
- Shaped upstands with a trio of patera over a foliate ground
- Generous sideboard with a width and depth of 138cm and 39cm respectively (54.25" & https://doi.org/10.25")
- Dresser base continuing the heavily carved appearance
- Arranged as a wide, drop-leaf front over a pair of cabinet doors with central, lidded shelf
 - Small brass lock escutcheon to the drop-down front key absent
