This is an antique cinnabar box. A Chinese, carved lacquer decorative lidded tray, dating to the late Qing dynasty, circa 1900.

- The striking crimson of cinnabar contrasting emphatically against the black ground
 - The dome top carved to depict a hunting scene within a landscape of trees and mountains
 - Six mounted riders busy themselves with their pack of hunting dogs
 - Carved diamond pattern to the background in very fine detail
 - Carved border to the circumference of the base with a 4 character mark to the underside

This is a profusely carved and highly appealing antique cinnabar box with superb detail and rich crimson hues. Delivered polished and ready to dazzle.
