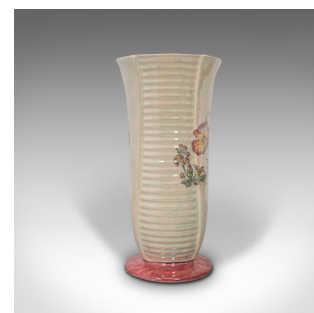
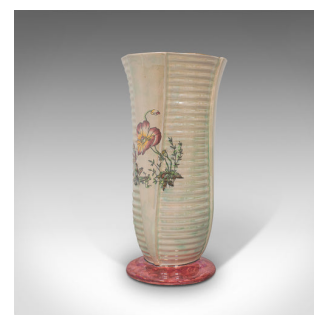


Vintage Flower Vase, English, Ceramic, Decorative, Lustre, Mid 20th, Circa 1950
