This is a large antique coffer. An Italian, walnut sword chest or linen trunk, dating to the mid 18th century, circa 1750.

- Wonderfully carved chest with generous proportion and copious fascination
- Displaying a desirable aged patina and good order
- Select Italian walnut shows fine grain interest and rich caramel hues
- Vigourously and well-carved front panel offers exquisite detail
 - Wide lid opens upon delightful snipe hinges with visible 'arrow head' showing through the top
- Opens to reveal a generous chest with lidded candle box to the side
- Superb carved fascia displays an arresting level of craftsmanship
- Floral bouquet to centre presented against a tight diamond pattern ground
- Large flower head patera to each side, radiating out from a smaller central flower
- Continuous foliate border with a quartet of long Italian fir leaves for incidental detail
- Delightful dovetail joints to the corners resonate with durability and strength
